Simon's team are working closely with our Vicar, The Reverend Nick Devenish in order to identify the vulnerable, to whom they deliver wholesome, freshly prepared meals, free of charge. They can do this by preparing "ready meals" available to locals to order for just £5. This prevents the farm produce going to waste, keeps jobs open, supports other suppliers and subsidises the cost of the free meals service.
