

From The Reverend Nick Devenish The Ascension Day to Pentecost Challenge with St Mark


The disciples witnessed Jesus ascend back to heaven. They had experienced Jesus appear and disappear post resurrection but this was to be for the last time. The disciples returned to Jerusalem to wait and to reflect. No doubt to reminisce, to discuss and to challenge one another as to all that they had witnessed. Jesus would usher a new way of living into the world through the ministry of the disciples.

We are living through an unprecedented time. Let us use this time of staying home and keeping safe and put ourselves with the disciples as they were reflecting on who Jesus is.

Let us read the Gospel of Mark using the same time frame as the disciples, who were waiting for Pentecost.

Let us read again the Jesus story over seven days.

If reading the Bible for first time a note about chapters and verses

Throughout the Bible large numbers are part of the text and signify a chapter. The smaller numbers relate to the number of verses that make up a chapter. The chapters and verses were not in the original writings and have been added at a later date to make it easier to find a passage. We use a shorthand so that Mark chapter 1 and verse 1 will be written as 'Mark 1. 1' or sometimes 'Mark 1 v 1.'
