We are not yet in a position to apply for a faculty to build the annex itself as further preliminary work is required to establish what may be buried under the building in relation to the design of the necessary foundations.

This current faculty is for an archaeological dig ONLY of the 5 trenches shown on the plan. These trenches will be reinstated and any evidence found considered and proposals submitted for a further faculty for the actual building will be submitted for consideration of the DAC.

The investigation works will be fully logged and reported to the Diocesan Advisory Committee, Diocesan Registrar and Chancellor. We have also consulted Historic England, SLDC Planning Dept & SLDC Conservation Officer

Before any work can start on an annex building we will have to refine the current proposals and submit a further faculty application for approval.
